Progress KS1 to KS2 over the four years

- The expected standard is 2 levels, 3 levels represents better than expected progress
- 2 levels progress in reading and writing and maths is 100% (over the 4 years the national average has varied between 88% and 92%)
- 3 levels progress:
 - Reading 57% (national 30%)
 - Writing 72% (national 30%)
 - Maths 60% (national 32%)
- Our intake into the school is “broadly average” - direct quote from OFSTED report October 2013, our results are significantly above average in all areas.
- Hence pupils over the last four years have made significantly better than expected progress and overall attainment is much higher than national figures.
